Liability:

- Drivers are responsible and liable for any personal injury or material damage they may cause within the Milence site.
- Milence is not liable, to the extent permitted by law, for damage resulting from theft, loss or other damage to the vehicle or (other property of) the users.
- Drivers and their passengers move around the site and park in the parking lot at their own risk, particularly regarding damage to or theft of their vehicle, its contents or themselves. Theft and other criminal offences will be reported to the local police for investigation.
- Drivers are responsible for any damage they or their passengers may cause to other parking lot, other drivers and their property, as well as to the site's operating staff and facilities. Any intentional damage to and/or vandalism of Milence property will not be tolerated and could result in a penalty or claim to the value of the cost of cleaning and/or replacement of the damaged item/s.
- In this respect, vehicles entering the secure parking lot must be duly insured, and customers must be able to justify, at Milence's first request, that they have met all legal and regulatory insurance obligations for which they are responsible. In the absence of such proof, Milence reserves the right to prohibit their vehicle from entering the secure charging site.
- The driver is responsible for ensuring that these general rules are made known to any of their passengers. In case of incidents or damage to the property of Milence or other clients the driver will held accountable.
